## Summary of Incident

Summary of How the Death Occurred: (max. 30,000 characters)

Summary:

On 05-23-2019 at approximately 2100 hrs Offender Christopher Beau Duboise DOB: 08-02-1982 was brought into custody by Midland County Sheriff's Office. Inmate was arrested for a Public Intoxication charge. The inmate was placed on a stool in booking awaiting to be received. While he was on the stool, he got up from the stool and attacked another inmate that was being received. Inmate was restrained by officers and escorted to ISO-B in Holding. Inmate Duboise refused to answer the suicide screening questions and was placed on a mental health check. At approximately 2155 hrs, Officer Rios got the inmate to answer the suicide screening questions and moved him from ISO-B to DETOX-D in Holding. Officer Rios continued to do her checks. At approximately 2155 hours, Officer Rios had a face to face check on Offender Duboise and asked him if he needed any water. She did her next check at approximately 2212 hrs and noticed Inmate was in the back of the cell with a shirt tied around his neck to the handicap bar. Officer Rios entered the cell and a medical emergency was called over the radio. Sgt. Horton assisted Officer Rios with getting the shirt off of the inmate's neck. As soon as the inmate was free from the noose, Sgt. Horton began administering CPR. Midland County Detention medical staff arrived on scene and also assisted in CPR. The AED was administered. EMS was notified and arrived on scene at the jail. CPR was continued and the inmate was transported by EMS to Midland Memorial Hospital. Cpl. Hunnicutt rode in the ambulance with EMS. Once at the hospital, the inmate was discharged from Midland County Detention Center custody. On 05-25-2019 at 2145 hrs, Justice of the Peace Judge Cobos pronounced Inmate Duboise as diseased.
