Summary of Incident

Summary of How the Death Occurred: (max. 30,000 characters)

Summary:

On Monday, March 16, 2020, at approximately 7:37 AM officers with the Lamesa Police Department were dispatched to Shiloh Inn, 1707 Lubbock Highway Lamesa, Dawson County, Texas, in reference to a suspicious Black male subject walking around the property half naked, carrying a staff. An officer arrived at the location and located the decedent. While the officer spoke with the decedent he spoke incoherently and rapidly. An officer asked decedent to walk downstairs to continue talking. Once the decedent got downstairs he fled from the officer on foot. The officer got into his patrol unit and attempted to locate the decedent. The officer located the decedent in front of 1909 Lubbock Highway. The officer attempted to make contact with the decedent. The decedent fled again on foot from the officer. The officer deployed his conducted electrical weapon, Taser 7, twice. Neither deployment was successful and the decedent continued to flee on foot from the officer. The decedent stopped and the officer caught up to him. The decedent crouched down then stood up and turned towards the officer. The officer tried to deliver a drive stun but the decedent maintained enough distant to keep from being drive stunned. The decedent then struck the officer in the face and began to flee on foot. The decedent hid in a carport at 105 North 18th Street. The officer located the decedent and placed in handcuffs. The officer asked for EMS to meet them at the jail to remove one prong from the Taser 7 from the decedents left arm. Upon arrival at the Dawson County Jail EMS removed the one prong. The decedent continue to act bizarre and speak incoherently. The officer escorted the decedent into the booking area and started doing booking paperwork. While the officer was doing the booking paperwork a jailer told the officer the decedent was not breathing. The officer then went and checked for a pulse on the decedent's neck. The officer did not a pulse, and was unsure if he was checking the proper place, so the officer checked the pulse in the decedent's wrist. The officer felt a a pulse. The officer also held his hand in front of the decedent's nose and mouth and could fell the decedent breathing. The officer requested by radio EMS respond back to the jail. The decedent was taken out of the handcuffs and placed on the floor in the booking room. CPR was started on the decedent. EMS arrived and transported the decedent to Medical Arts Hospital in Lamesa, Dawson County, Texas. Doctor Anthony Gipson pronounced the time of death at 09:28 AM.
