Summary of Incident

Summary of How the Death Occurred: (max. 30,000 characters)

Summary:

On Thursday February 13, 2020 at about 10:28 AM Amarillo SWAT and NARCOTICS AGENTS were conducting surveillance in the 1300 block of N Buchanan. Aaron Marcus Valdez HM 19 was a wanted suspect in three shooting incidents on 2/11/2020 with three victims at the three different locations. Amarillo Police Officers, members of the SWAT Team, had attempted to arrest Aaron Marcus Valdez HM 19 for multiple felony warrants. While in the course of taking Valdez into custody at 1306 N Buchanan, Valdez drew a concealed Glock 19 handgun and pointed it at officers. Officers fired a total of eight rounds to prevent Valdez assault on them. Valdez dropped the gun when the rounds struck him. He was taken into custody and provided with first aid. He was transported to Nwth and at 12:10 PM died of his injuries.

2/11/2020

8:04 pm 2020-502985 Aaron Valdez and Lozaro Campos encounter Kyle Franklin WM 30 and his girlfriend Tabitha Lawlis WF 29 at Thompson Park. Valdez approached Franklin asking, "Are you Henry?" When Franklin replied no, Valdez shot multiple rounds into the victim's vehicle. Victim Franklin is struck twice by

bullets, left arm and left ear. Victim Lawlis is struck once by a bullet in the right forearm.

8:21 pm 2020-502986 Officers dispatched to 2500 block of N. Wilson on shots fired. Officers locate Lazaro Campos with a GSW to the left leg. Campos admits he was present when Aaron Valdez shot two people in Thompson Park a few minutes ago. Valdez then shot Campos and took Campos vehicle.

8:30 pm 2020-502987 Officers dispatched to 1712 NE 24, D&T Store on shots fired. Officers locate witness who described Valdez covered in blood coming into the store with a gun in his hand and his face covered. Valdez almost immediately leaves the store and fires multiple 9 mm rounds in the parking lot.

Valdez also matched the physical description, lived in the general area of and behaved in a manner consistent with one of the suspects in Demond Thomas Homicide, APD 19-527366 from 12/17/2019.

5:31 pm 2019-527366 Victim Demond Thomas was shot while driving his vehicle EB on the 1700 block of NE 24th near the D&T Convenience Store. Demond was transported to NWTH with a GSW to his head. He died of his injuries early in the morning of Wednesday December 18, 2019. Video of the incident was obtained from nearby D&T Store. Suspect was described as a HM 18-22. One witness recognized the shooter as someone he went to high school with. On 2/24/2020, this witness identified Aaron Valdez from a photo array as one of the two shooters in this case.

On Friday February 14, 2020, APD CSI attended autopsy. Preliminary cause of death was penetrating GSW to the head. Aaron Valdez also had two penetrating through and through GSW torso injuries and a through and through GSW of his arm. One bullet projectile was recovered from his body.

On Wednesday February 26, 2020, the Potter County Grand Jury reviewed the facts of the case as an Original Matter. The Grand Jury determined the shooting of Aaron Valdez to be justified. This case is Exceptionally Cleared Death of Offender. Sgt Dunn 250 2/26/2020 1326
